## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That C. R. HIBBERD,

of La Grande, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of

the waters of Wolf Creek, tributary of Powder River,

for the purpose of the irrigation of 352.5 acres of land;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume six, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1883 for 107.5 acres; May 23, 1882 for 135 acres; 1879 for 110 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Fifteen; 28 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter, and 39.5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Fourteen; 10 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 35 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter, and 38 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Fifteen; 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter; 12 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Fourteen; 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Fifteen; 30 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter, and 40 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Fourteen, Township Six South, Range Thirty-nine East of Willamette Meridian, in Union County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
