of 13975 NW Burton Road, Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a reservoir constructed under Application No. R-40180, Permit No. R-4486

a tributary of Willow Creek irrigation of 8.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 29981 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 20, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4.4 scre feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEX SWX, as projected within Flippin DLC 55, Section 28, T. 1 N., R. 1 W., W. M., 20 feet South and 20 feet East from Westerly NW Corner, Flippin DLC 55.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_of\_one cubic\_foot\_per\_second per\_acre, a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-4486,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
