CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EUGENE STOCKHOFF

of Route 1, Box 158, Dayton, State of Oregon 97114, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of two wells

a tributary of Lambert Slough (Willamette River) for the purpose of irrigation of 252.4 acres under Permit No. G-3392 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 5, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.38 cubic feet per second, being 1.27 c.f.s. from Well No. 1 and 1.11 c.f.s. from Well No. 2

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the #1-SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Peters DLC 58, Section 21, #2-SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Peters DLC 58, Section 20, T. 5 S., R. 3 W., W. M., #1-10 feet North and 3160 feet East, #2-30 feet North and 1320 feet East, both from SW Corner, Peters DLC 58.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. If in any subsequent proceedings it is determined that the source of water herein described is that claimed in Ground Water Registration Certificate numbered GR-58 and the right claimed in the registration certificate is confirmed, that part of the right herein confirmed shall be of no force or effect,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
