CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **JOHN J. KLASSEN** 97338
of **Route 3, Box 85, Dallas**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
North Fork Ash Creek

a tributary of **Willamette River** for the purpose of
irrigation of 13.4 acres

under Permit No. **15658** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from **December 10, 1943**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.17 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$** , as projected within **Harris DLC 44**,
Section 3, T. 8 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 1960 feet North and 490 feet East, 1940 feet North
and 700 feet East, 1890 feet North and 980 feet East from SE Corner, Grant DLC 43.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to
a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during
the irrigation season of each year;

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

12.4 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
1.0 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Both as projected within Harris DLC 44
Section 3
T. 8 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order
of the State Engineer entered January 30, 1973, and supersedes certificate of water
right heretofore issued to John J. Klassen and recorded at page 19614, Volume 14,
State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
