that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0-15 cubic foct per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NH's NE's, Section 8, T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 530 feet South and 820 feet East from N's Corner, Section 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
