CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN C. COCHRANE

of Merlin, State of Oregon 97532
to the use of the waters of Quartz Creek, has a right

a tributary of Jump-Off-Joe Creek for the purpose of
irrigation of 30.7 acres, and stock
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1886

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.44 cubic foot per
second

The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 6, T. 35 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

- 5.7 acres SW 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 5
 - 2.0 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 6
 - 23.0 acres NW 1/4 NW 1/4

An order of the State Engineer entered February 27, 1974, approved a change in point
of diversion for the irrigation of 9.3 acres. This certificate is issued to con-
firm the remaining right and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to John
C. Cochrane and recorded at page 16499, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right
Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
