CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That BENJAMIN GEORGE

of Kerby, State of Oregon, 97531, has a right
 to the use of the waters of
 East Fork Illinois River
 a tributary of Illinois River for the purpose of
 irrigation of 16.0 acres
 and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
 the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 13, at page 70; that the priority of the right thereby
 confirmed dates from May, 1887

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one cubic foot per
 second for each 50 acres of land irrigated during the irrigation season from
 April 1 to November 1 of each year.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 27, T. 39 S. R. 8 W., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
 follows:

9.4 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
 6.6 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 16
 T. 39 S. R. 8 W., W.M.

An order of the State Engineer entered November 18, 1974, approved a change in place
 of use for the irrigation of 4.6 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the
 remaining right and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Benjamin
 George and recorded at page 13861, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
 The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
 use herein described.
