of Route 1, Box 310 A, Silverton , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Abiqua Creek

a tributary of Pudding River irrigation of 2-13 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. ``14449 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 24, 1940

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW1 NW1, Section 29, T. 6 S., R. I E., W. M., 1100 feet South and 600 feet East from NW Corner, Section 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 24 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.13 acres NWt NWt Section 29 T. 6 S., R. 1 E., W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered August 21, 1968, and together with the certificate recorded at page 36490, Volume 28, supersedes certificate of water right here-tofore issued to John Morley and recorded at page 14305, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
