that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed three acre feet per acre during any irrigation season (with further limitations contained in paragraph 24 of said decree)

The point of diversion is located in the SE's NE's, Section 6, T. 4 S., R. 13 E., W. M., 3710 feet North and 520 feet West, 3480 feet North and 650 feet West, both from SE Corner, Section 6.
