CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That JNO. G. HOYE

of Medical Springs, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Big Creek, Martin and School House Gulch, tributary of Powder River for the purpose of the irrigation of 71 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875 for Tract No. 1, 1876 for Tract No. 2 and 1895 and Tract No. 3

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1 from Big Creek: 30 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Two and 12 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section One, Township Seven South, Range Forty-one East of Willamette Meridian,

Tract No. 2 from Big Creek: 21 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Two, Township Seven South, Range Forty-one East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 3 from Martin and School House Gulch: 8 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Thirty-five, Township Six South, Range Forty-one East of Willamette Meridian,

*part of div. changed for part of these lands - See Sp. Or Vol. 1 p. 412*

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
