of Route 1, Box 4, Cloverdale , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream

a tributary of Nestucca River for the purpose of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and garden, use in a dairy barn, and stock under Permit No. 33247 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 5, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic, 0.005 c.f.s. for dairy barn use and 0.005 c.f.s. for stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW2 NE2, Section 21, T. 4 S., R. 10 W., W. M., 70 feet North and 2420 feet West from E% Corner, Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ______ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW% SE% Section 21 T. 4 S., R. 10 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
