CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That CHARLES V. HOWELL

of Richland, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Powder River, tributary of Snake River, and Daly Creek, tributary of Powder River for the purpose of the irrigation of 150 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from May 20, 1909 for 30 acres; August 1863 for 60 acres and 1890 for 60 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

30 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-five, Township Nine South, Range Forty-five: 37 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-five: 23 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 10 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 20 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter and 30 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Thirty-six, Township Nine South, Range Forty-five, all East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon (Lands irrigated from Daly Creek in Sections 25 and 36 and from Powder River in Section 36 are also supplied from Eagle Creek under date of 1901 through Howell Ditch)

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
