under Permit No. G-1690 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 22, 1960

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0-10 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SW1 NE1, Section 29, T. 1 N., R. 35 E., W. M.,

540 feet North and 1230 feet East from Center, Section 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurte, ant, is as follows:
