CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **FRED MILLER**

of **Sumpter Stage, Baker**, State of **Oregon**, **97814**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **two springs**

a tributary of **Powder River** for the purpose of **domestic use for one family, irrigation of 13.5 acres, and stock**

under Permit No. **31176** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **January 10, 1966**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.36 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for stock, 0.34 c.f.s. for irrigation from spring #2, and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic from spring #1**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **NW¹ SE⁴, Section 29, T. 10 S., R. 38 E., W. M., #1-2240 feet South and 5100 feet East, #2-3900 feet South and 3780 feet East, both from NW Corner, Section 29.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fortieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **3 $\frac{1}{4}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;**

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**Domestic NE¹ NE⁴
2.0 acres NW¹ NE⁴
Stock and 8.1 acres SW¹ NE⁴
0.1 acre NE¹ NW⁴
3.3 acres SE¹ NW⁴
Section 29
T. 10 S., R. 38 E., W.M.**

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
