that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEZ SEZ, Section 4, T. 4 N., R. 7 W., W. H., 25 feet North 87 degrees 432 minutes West from SE Corner, Lot 6, Block 4, Elderberry and Nehalem Homesites.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
