CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **JOHN & GEORGINA WAHL**
97450
of **Box 43, Langlois**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Elk River

a tributary of **Pacific Ocean** for the purpose of
irrigation of **36.7 acres**

under Permit No. **33935** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from **October 15, 1968**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.46 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream,
The point of diversion is located in the **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 17, T. 32 S., R. 15 W.,**
W. M., #1-2020 feet North and 1120 feet West, #2-2200 feet North and 2080 feet
West, #3-1960 feet North and 2630 feet West, all from SE Corner, Section 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eighth** of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to
a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet** per acre for each acre irrigated during
the irrigation season of each year and is subject to the terms and conditions of
an agreement between the Oregon State Game Commission and the Oregon State Fish
Commission and the applicant which has been recorded in the Miscellaneous Records
of the State Engineer and by reference made a part hereof,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

0.1 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
19.2 acres Lot 2 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
0.4 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
As projected within G. Dyer DLC 39
0.7 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
As projected within A. Dyer DLC 38
3.3 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
3.2 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Both as projected within G. Dyer DLC 39
0.2 acre Lot 3 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
4.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
5.6 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 17
T. 32 S., R. 15 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
