CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of P. O. Box 328, Gold Beach, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Gregg Creek

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of campsites and domestic use for two families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre in area

under Permit No. 36056 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 23, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic, and 0.01 c.f.s. for campsites

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4), Section 20, T. 35 S., R. 14 W., W. M., 910 feet South and 1380 feet East from NW Corner, Section 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

campsites Lot 4 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4)
domestic Lot 5 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4)
Section 20
T. 35 S., R. 14 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
