## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ROBERT G. MCKENZIE, JR.

of Box 187, Port Orford , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-45820, Permit No. R-5433

a tributary of Floras Lake for the purpose of

irrigation, frost control, and cramberry harvesting of 23.8 acres

under Permit No. 34192 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 28, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1-19 cubic feet per second, being 0-60 c.f.s. for irrigation, 1-19 c.f.s. for cranberry harvesting from the unnamed stream and reservoir, and 0-35 c.f.s. for frost control from the unnamed stream

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEX SWX, Section 29, Pumps-NEX NWX, SEX NWX, Section 32, T. 31 S., R. 15 W., W. M., 30 feet South and 490 feet East from NW Corner, NEX SWX, Section 29, Pumps-1900 feet North and 960 feet East, 1100 feet\*

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under permit No. R-5433 for cranberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow\*\* and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

12.3 acres NET NWT 11.5 acres SET NWT Section 32 T. 31 S., R. 15 W., W. M.

- \* North and 1030 feet East, both from SW Corner, SEt NWt, Section 32.
- \*\* and storage from reservoir constructed under permit No. R-5433

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
