CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That JOHN D. HULICK

of Keating, State of Oregon 97814 has a right to the use of the waters of Tucker Creek, tributary of Powder River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 61 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1872 for 15 acres; 1825 for 15 acres; 1864 for 18 acres; 1875 for 8 acres and 1902 for 5 acres.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

9.5 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 15.5 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter and 5 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Nine; 4.5 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 21.5 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter and 5 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Four, Township Eight South, Range Forty-two East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.
