or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWX NWX, Section 32, T. 3 N., R. 18 E., W. M., 4410 feet North and 1150 feet East from SW Corner, Section 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre.
