a tributary of Snake River supplemental irrigation of 44.5 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 34913 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 17, 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.56 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NEX NEX), Section 1, T. 21 S., R. 46 E., W. M., 680 feet South and 100 feet West from NE Corner, Section 1.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre'or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of an agreement between the Owyhee Irrigation District and the applicant recorded in the records of the State Engineer and by reference made a part hereof,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

36.1 acres Lot 1 (NEt NEt) 8.4 acres Lot 2 (NWt NEt) Section 1 T. 21 S., R. 46 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
