CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CHARLES ELLS

of P. O. Box 25, Port Orford, State of Oregon, 97465, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of two unnamed streams and four reservoirs constructed under Application No. R-46225, Permit No. R-5500

a tributary of Sixes River for the purpose of irrigation, frost control, and harvesting of 12.7 acres of cranberries

under Permit No. 34536 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 15, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.76 cubic feet per second, being 0.25 c.f.s. from east stream and reservoirs & 0.07 c.f.s. from west stream and reservoirs for irrigation, 1.32 c.f.s. from east stream, 0.44 c.f.s. from west stream for frost control, 0.49 c.f.s. from east stream*

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the #1 & 4-SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, #2 & 3-NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 32, T. 31 S., R. 15 W., W. M., #1-1500 feet South and 380 feet West, #2-780 feet South and 380 feet West, #3-1040 feet South and 960 feet West, #4-1780 feet South and 1190 feet**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

12.7 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 32
T. 31 S., R. 15 W., W. M.

* and reservoirs and 0.15 c.f.s. from west stream and reservoirs for harvesting,

** West, all from NE Corner, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 32.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
