CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That RAY BROTHERS

97869  
of P. O. Box 307, Prairie City, State of Oregon, has made proof  
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of  
waste water

a tributary of Indian Creek for the purpose of  
irrigation of 16.0 acres

under Permit No. 28273 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters  
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby  
confirmed dates from May 29, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
0.40 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 4, T. 14 S., R. 33 E.,  
W. M., 90 feet South and 920 feet East, 460 feet South and 1490 feet East, both  
from SW Corner, Section 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second  
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to  
a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during  
the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of  
water is limited to the period when the flow of the John Day River is more than  
30 cubic feet per second at USGS Gage No. 14-0465 and more than 20 cubic feet per  
second at USGS Gage No. 14-0480, and shall also be limited to the water available  
at the proposed points of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to  
compel the continuance of the waste water, and shall  
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is  
appurtenant, is as follows:

5.4 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
7.2 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
3.4 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 33  
T. 13 S., R. 33 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
