192, of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at page 152, on the 19th day of November, 1915; that the priority of right hereby confirmed dates from May 20, 1912, that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 2.5 acre feet.
