a tributary of Willamette River irrigation of 8.4 acres and stock

under Permit No. 36053 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 22, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second, being 0.11 c.f.s. for irrigation from long Tom River and 0.01 c.f.s. for stock use from Gold Creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWX SWX, Section 21, T. 17 S., R. 6 W., W. M., River - 40 feet South and 420 feet East, Creek - 350 feet South and 710 feet East both from WX Corner, Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Stock and 8.4 acres NWt SWt Section 21 T. 17 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
