## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of Route 1, Box 231, Nyssa , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Snake River

a tributary of Columbia River irrigation of 45.3 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 32352 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 17, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1-13 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (SEt NWt), Lot 4 (NEX SWk), Section 30,
T. 20 S., R. 47 E., W. M., 2450 feet South and 1380 feet East from NW Corner, Section 30, 1330 feet North and 1390 feet East from SW Corner, Section 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per sare for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.5 acre Lot 2 (NWk NWk)
18.2 acres Lot 3 (SWk NWk)
26.2 acres Lot 4 (NWk SWk)
0.4 acre Lot 5 (SWk SWk)
Section 30
T. 20 S., R. 47 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
