CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That VIRGIL ISON, EDNA MacDOUGALL, and

ALEXANDER MacDOUGALL, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
Baker the waters of Powder River, tributary of Snake River,
for the purpose of irrigation of 83 acres of land;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume six, at page 291 ;
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1904 for 43 acres in Tract No. 1,
April 24, 1905 for 40 acres in Tract No. 2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one
cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and
limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1: 6.25 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 16.75
acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 16 acres in the Southeast quarter
of Northwest quarter; 3 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 1 acre
in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Nine;

Tract No. 2: 15 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 24
acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter, and 1 acres in the Northeast
quarter of southwest quarter of Section Nine, Township Nine South, Range Forty East
of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
