CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JAMES H. McCLURE

of **Elgin** , State of **Oregon** , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Indian Creek**

a tributary of **Grande Ronde River** for the purpose of **irrigation of 230.6 acres**

under Permit No. **32125** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **November 3, 1966**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **1.50 cubic feet per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **#1-NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 26, #2-NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, T. 1 N., R. 39 E., W. M., #1-1880 feet North and 940 feet West, #2-230 feet South and 1350 feet East, both from NW Corner, Section 36.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fortieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **3 acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
