CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DENNIS G. & KAREN M. BAILEY

97040

of Route 1, Box 18, Mosier, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of West Fork Mosier Creek and Mosier Creek

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 1.7 acres

under Permit No. 36813 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 17, 1972

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.035 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic use and 0.03 c.f.s. for irrigation from West Fk. Mosier Creek when available with any deficiency in the available supply from West Fk. Mosier Creek to be made up by appropriation from Mosier* or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the #1-NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, #2-SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 18, T. 2 N., R. 12 E., W. M., #1-610 feet South and 20 feet East, #2-50 feet North and 640 feet East, both from NW Corner, Section 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-sixtieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 1.7 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 19
T. 2 N., R. 12 E., W. M.

* Creek, provided that the total quantity diverted from both sources shall not exceed 0.035 cubic foot per second.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
