CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That C. S. JACKSON

of Portland, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Silver Creek, tributary of Powder River for the purpose of power and mining

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1892 for Tract No. 1 and 1901 for Tract No. 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 8 cubic feet per second; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1 for the development of 193 horsepower—Place of Use, Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Five, Township Nine South, Range Thirty-seven East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 2 for the development of 357 horsepower and for mining: Place of use, Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Five, Township Nine South Range Thirty-seven East of Willamette Meridian.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
