**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That ROBERT & STUART LANCEFIELD**

97302  
of 3120 Mulberry Drive S., Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof  
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of  
Salt Creek and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-41605, Permit No.  
R-4713  
a tributary of South Yamhill River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 84.2 acres

under Permit No. 31196 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters  
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby  
confirmed dates from November 15, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
2.05 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Walling DLC 42,  
Section 17, NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Walling DLC 42, NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected  
within Watt DLC 73, Section 20, T. 5 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 4020 feet North and \*

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second  
per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be  
further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre  
irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage  
from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-4713,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is  
appurtenant, is as follows:
