CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DR. GLEN E. SCHWENKE
97071

of **225 South Pacific Highway, Woodburn**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the **STATE ENGINEER** of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-43976, Permit No. R-4944

a tributary of **Hess Creek** for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of **24.6 acres**

under Permit No. **32279** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **August 18, 1967**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.31 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$** , as projected within Fulquarts DLC 70, Section 36, T. 3 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 1470 feet North and 420 feet East from SW Corner, Section 36.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-4944, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.4 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
0.8 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Both as projected within Fulquarts DLC 70
Section 35

4.0 acres Lot 9 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
6.8 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
11.6 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Both as projected within Fulquarts DLC 70
Section 36
T. 3 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
