CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FIDEL BROTHERS

of Route 1, Box 157, Yamhill, State of Oregon 97148, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, Salt Creek, & reservoir constructed under Application No. R-45354,* a tributary of Yamhill River for the purpose of irrigation of 270.8 acres and supplemental irrigation of 7.5 acres under Permit No. 33951 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 5, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.07 cubic feet per second, being 2.20 c.f.s. from unnamed stream and 0.87 c.f.s. from Salt Creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Str.-SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Cr.-SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Perkins DLC 55, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Harris DLC 54, Section 31, T. 2 S., R. 4 W., W.M., Cr.-220 feet North and 1380 feet West, 1960 feet South and 2260 feet West, Str.-50 feet North and 1420 feet West, all from SE Corner, Perkins DLC 55.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{4}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under permit No. R-5378 provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
