CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FORREST SOLOMON

97426
of **Route 1, Box 415, Creswell**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and Umpqua River

a tributary of **Pacific Ocean** for the purpose of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one-half acre in area, and irrigation of 36.0 acres under Permit No. **34320** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **April 16, 1969**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.46 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use from stream and 0.45 c.f.s. for irrigation from Umpqua River

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the River-SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 4, Str.-NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9, both as projected within Sawyer DLC 49, T. 22 S., R. 8 W., W. M.; River-970 feet North & 1280 feet East, str.-220 feet South & 1900 feet East, both from SW Corner, Section 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

14.8 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
17.7 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
0.1 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
All as projected within Sawyer DLC 49

3.4 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
As projected within Sawyer DLC 49
Section 5
T. 22 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
