CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JAMES DANIEL NEWKIRK

97462

of Kellogg Star Rt., Box 115-D, Oakland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Yellow Creek

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 8.0 acres

under Permit No. 36237 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 24, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.105 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic use and 0.10 c.f.s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, As projected within Delaunays DLC 37, Section 12, T. 24 S., R. 7 W., W. M., 2220 feet North and 4270 feet West, 2140 feet North and 4540 feet West, both from SE Corner, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.4 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Domestic and 0.5 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Both as projected within Delaunays DLC 37
Section 12

0.1 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
As projected within Delaunays DLC 37
Section 13
T. 24 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
