CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That STIREWALT BROTHERS, J. M. & D. W.

of **Kimberly**, State of **Oregon**, 97843
 to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
John Day River

a tributary of **Columbia River** for the purpose of
irrigation of 58.0 acres and supplemental irrigation of 65.4 acres

under Permit No. **36655** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
 confirmed dates from **January 26, 1972**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
 aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
1.90 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
 The point of diversion is located in the **SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, T. 9 S., R. 26 E., W. M.,
 1890 feet North and 2040 feet West from SE Corner, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
 right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fortieth** of one cubic foot per second
 per acre, **or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to**
a diversion of not to exceed 5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during
the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein
shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right ex-
isting for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein;

and shall
 conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
 appurtenant, is as follows:
