CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That RICHARD A. SMITH

of **Route 1, Box 66, Bonanza**, State of **Oregon**, **97623**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **House Spring and Meadow Spring**

a tributary of **Miller Creek (Lost River)** for the purpose of **irrigation of 25.0 acres**

under Permit No. **34474** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **June 20, 1969**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.32 cubic foot per second, being 0.09 c.f.s. from House Spring and 0.23 c.f.s. from Meadow Spring**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 32, T. 39 S., R. 13 E., W. M., 2960 feet North and 2780 feet East, 2420 feet North and 3780 feet East, both from SW Corner, Section 32.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;**

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

House Spring
7.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 32
T. 39 S., R. 13 E., W. M.

Meadow Spring
5.2 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
12.8 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 32
T. 39 S., R. 13 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
