of Rural Route, Grass Valley , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Buck Hollow

a tributary of Deschutes River irrigation of 46.3 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 33149 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 8, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed \$5.57 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWX SWX, SEX SWX, Section 29, SWX NEX, NWX NWX, NEX SEX, Section 30, NWX NEX, Section 32, T. 4 S., R. 16 E., W. M., 730 feet South and 4490 feet West from NE Corner, Section 30, 2980 feet North and 1380 feet West,\*

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
