or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEX NEX, Section 6, T. 3 S., R. 38 E., W. M., #1-3060 feet North and 530 feet West, #2-3060 feet North and 510 feet West from SE Corner, Section 6.
