a tributary of South Myrtle Creek irrigation of 21.1 acres, domestic use for two families

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 34147 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 6, 1969 for 0.13 c.f.s. and April 8, 1969 for 0.14 c.f.s.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0-27 cubic foot per second, being 0-26 c-f-s- for irrigation and 0-01 c-f-s- for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWA NEX, as projected within Cornelisons DLC 46, Section 34, T. 29 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 280 feet North and 970 feet East, 540 feet North and 920 feet East, both from SW Corner, J. Cornelisons DLC 46.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.6 acres NWt NEt

Domestic and 10.2 acres SWt NEt

Domestic and 5.4 acres NEt NWt

0.9 acre SEt NWt

All as projected within Cornelisons DLC 46

Section 34

T. 29°S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
