under Permit No. 37061 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 20, 1972

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.095 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. for stock and 0.09 c.f.s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWX SWX, as projected within Cox DLC 49, Section 20, T. 28 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 70 feet North and 2100 feet East from SW Corner, Cox DLC 49.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shal

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.8 acres SWt NWt 4.7 acres NWt SWt Both as projected within Cox DLC 49 Section 20 T. 28 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
