CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **HENRY G. WOLFF** 97624
of **Star Route, Box 77 A, Chiloquin**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Williamson River

a tributary of **Upper Klamath Lake** for the purpose of
irrigation of **54.3 acres**

under Permit No. **30801** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from **July 13, 1965**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
1.36 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the **1-Lot 12 (N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), 2-Lot 45 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$),
Section 20, T. 35 S., R. 7 E., W.M., 1-220 ft. South and 2360 feet West, 2-1020
feet South and 90 feet West, both from NE Corner, Lot 44 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 20.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fortieth** of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to
a diversion of not to exceed **3 acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during
the irrigation season of each year;

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

5.2 acres Lot 40 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
7.6 acres Lot 41 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
5.0 acres Lot 2 (N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
15.2 acres Lot 7 (S $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
14.8 acres Lot 10 (N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
4.0 acres Lot 19 (S $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
0.7 acre Lot 44 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
0.6 acre Lot 6 (S $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
1.2 acres Lot 12 (N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)

T. 35 S., R. 7 E., W. M.

use herein described.
