CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That KILLAMACUE LAND RESERVOIR & ROCK CREEK IRRIGATION COMPANY
of Haines, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Killamacue Lake and Reservoir
for the purpose of Storage

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from August 22, 1900

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 798.07 acre feet

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Water to be used for irrigation on lands having water rights determined herein, or hereafter, at the time of filing the Statement and Proof of Claims
