31351 under Permit No. of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 16, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.5 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 NW4, Section 10, T. 3 N., R. 27 E., W. M., 2020 feet South and 30 feet East from NW Corner, Section 10.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 44 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is

appurtenant, is as follows:
