CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That IRA F. SPARLIN, M. M. MORRISON, D. S. RIGEL,
IRVEN RIGEL, AND NOAH RIGEL

% Irven Rigel
of 1125 Panther Gulch Road, Williams, State of Oregon 97544, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
East Fork of Williams Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
irrigation of 108 acres

under Permit No. 2600 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
August 3, 1915
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
1.35 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, Township 39 South, Range
5 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right
is appurtenant, is as follows:

for domestic use and the irrigation of 25 acres. This certificate is issued to
confirm the remaining right and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to
Ira F. Sparlin, Bert C. Bostwick, M. M. Morrison, D. S. Rigel, Irven Rigel, and
Noah Rigel and recorded at page 2150, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right
Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
