## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** L. E. AND A. C. MILLARD

of Applegate, State of Oregon 97530, has  
a right to the use of the waters of Thompson Creek

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 34.5 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the  
right thereby confirmed dates from 1907

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.494 cubic foot per  
second.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 8, Township 39 South, Range 4  
West, W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

7.5 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
10.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
17.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 5  
T. 39 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

A certificate of water right issued to L. E. and A. C. Millard and recorded at page  
973, Volume 25, State Record of Water Right Certificates confirms the right to  
use of water for irrigation of 35.6 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use  
of water appurtenant to 1.1 acres was canceled by order of the Water Resources  
Director entered September 11, 1975. This certificate is issued to confirm the  
remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate  
heretofore issued to L. E. and A. C. Millard.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
