CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of 724 Nebergall Loop S., Albany, State of Oregon, 97321, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director of a right to the use of the waters of Willamette River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean
irrigation of 189.7 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 35078 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 27, 1971 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.37 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Gallatin Adkins DLC 43, Section 25, T. 10 S., R. 4 W., W. M., SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Gallatin Adkins DLC 79, Section 30, T. 10 S., R. 3 W., W. M., #1-1120 feet North and 3140 feet West, #3-240 feet North and 1480 feet West, #4-250 feet North and 560 feet West, all from NW Corner, Sarah Adkins DLC 45.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
