CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **PAT D. PRICE** **97457**

of **South Myrtle Rt., Box 210, Myrtle Creek**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **South Myrtle Creek, a spring, an unnamed stream, and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-45310, Permit No. R-5348** a tributary of **Myrtle Creek** for the purpose of **irrigation of 4.3 acres, supplemental irrigation of 4.8 acres, and domestic use for one family** under Permit No. **33831** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **August 22, 1968**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.07 cubic foot per second, being 0.04 c.f.s. from South Myrtle Creek and 0.02 c.f.s. from unnamed stream for irrigation, 0.01 c.f.s. from spring for domestic, and 1.0 acre foot from reservoir for supplemental irrigation**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the **Creek-NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Unn. stream and reservoir-SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Spring-NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, T. 29 S., R. 4 W., W. M., Creek-640 feet South and 170 feet West, Reservoir-1340 feet South and 1830 feet East, Spring-2910 feet South and ***

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under permit No. R-5348 provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein and further limited to the use of stored water only on the lands described as *

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
