## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ED E. DIMMICK,

of Rogue River, State of Oregon, 97537, has  
a right to the use of the waters of Evans Creeka tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of  
domestic, stock, and irrigation of 1.0 acreand that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
JACKSON County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the  
right thereby confirmed dates from 1896that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.35 cubic foot per  
second.The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 6, T. 35 S., R. 3 W., W. M.A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:1.0 acre in W $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 11  
T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.An order of the State Engineer entered June 6, 1975, approved a change in point  
of diversion for the irrigation of 20.0 acres. This certificate is issued to  
confirm the remaining right not involved in the change and supersedes the  
certificate heretofore issued to Ed E. Dimmick recorded at page 32768, State  
Record of Water Right Certificates.And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
