CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JAMES TREFREN

of Rogue River, State of Oregon, 97537, has
a right to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
domestic, stock, and irrigation of 4.9 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1902

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.081 cubic foot
per second.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

4.9 acres in Lot 9
(SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15;
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 22)
T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The above Lot designation is in Pleasant Valley Farm Tracts, as designated,
numbered and described on the official plat thereof now on record in the Office
of the County Clerk of Jackson County.

An order of the State Engineer entered June 6, 1975, approved a change in
point of diversion for the irrigation of 13.2 acres. This certificate is issued
to confirm the remaining right and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to
James Trefren and recorded at page 32787, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
